

## POOL RULES

### NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY AT BAYWOOD VILLAGE POOL

**Each resident/homeowner is responsible for their family members and guests while using the pool facilities. Any misconduct or damage could lead to loss of pool privileges and/or monetary assessments. All rules will be followed. Decisions by pool attendant or HBI Security in upholding these rules are final.**

1. Operating Hours: The pool and spa shall be open from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM.
2. Adult Swimming: The first 15 minutes of each hour are for adult swimming only, if request is made to pool attendant.
3. Curfew: After 8:00 PM, persons under 18 are prohibited from the pool area unless accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for the minor's conduct.
4. Juveniles **under 14 are not** allowed in the pool area without a parent or adult guardian (18 or older). Before the juvenile can enter the pool area, the adult guardian shall introduce herself/himself to the pool attendant when present.
5. Guests: Juveniles 14 to 17 may have one guest each. A resident must accompany guests under the age of 18.
6. Identification: Each resident and guest shall wear or display a Baywood Pool Badge. Badges will be presented upon the request of a Baywood staff member, any adult resident, pool attendant, HBI Security Officer, or the Alameda Police Department. Persons without badges will be considered trespassers.
7. Not Allowed: Glass containers, Excessive Noise (Including amplified music), Running, Diving, Hazardous, Illegal, or Disturbing Behavior, Scuba Gear, Skateboards, or Skates.
8. Floatation Devices: Floatation devices for small children are allowed under supervision of parent or adult guardian.
9. Showers: Suntan oils and lotions must be removed by showering before entering the pool.
