Fences: Short

Original developer short fences shall not be repaired other than minor repairs, e.g., replacement of a broken board.

Brick short fences will be considered for approval as a replacement for the short wood fence. If there is brick facing on the house, the brick fence must match the brick on the house.

New:

On a case-by-case basis, the PAC may approve a short section of three-foot high, black wrought iron fence, including a black wrought iron gate, to separate the back yard from the front yard. For example, this type of short fence may be used to keep a small pet in the back yard. The wrought iron "separator" will <u>not</u> be approved to replace the short or tall fence. A short, wrought iron fence will <u>only</u> be considered for placement on the back half of the property in <u>either one</u> of the following cases.

- The wrought iron fence must connect in a straight line <u>from</u> the side of the residence <u>to</u> the tall fence on the property. The wrought iron fence may not connect with the short wood fence.
- The wrought iron fence must connect in a straight line from the side of one residence to the side of the neighboring residence, provided that both property owners agree to the placement of the wrought iron fence. The property owner who files the request for approval from the PAC must include a letter of concurrence from their neighbor as part of the approval request.
